

# THE FLORENCE HAWLEY ELLIS & ANDREA ELLIS PUEBLO INDIAN GRADUATE SCHOLARSHIP FUND

- This scholarship fund is established for the purpose of providing college tuition assistance to qualified students who are from the Pueblos of the Southwest, including Zuni and Hopi.

## Eligibility criteria:

- Graduate Student enrolled in a New Mexico institution.
- Commitment to Tribal Community Service.
- Fields: Humanities, Culturally Based Economic Development, Indigenous Language Preservation, Environmental Studies, Education, Community Development, Health, Law & Justice, Leadership, Tribal Governance, or Business, or related fields.

## 'Application package' must include the following documentation:

**\*\*Note: There is no application, include contact information in a header or footer on your essay page.**

- One full-page essay explaining your purpose for attaining a Master's degree and its relation to your commitment to Tribal Community Service.
- Certificate of Tribal Affiliation.
- A copy of Official Transcript from most recent completed semester/term.  
(Transcript may be issued to student and/or mailed to ENIPC, Inc. Higher Education office.)

## Scholarship details:

The Scholarship is a one-time award of \$800 (\$400 for Fall 2008 semester and \$400 for Spring 2009 semester). This scholarship fund has been established with an initial contribution from Dr. Florence Hawley Ellis, Professor Emeritus at UNM, and her daughter, Andrea Ellis and is held by the National Ghost Ranch Foundation, Inc. Other contributions to this fund are invited and encouraged. All contributions will be considered part of the principal and will be invested or held in interest-bearing accounts. Only the earnings on principal will be utilized to fund scholarships. An advisory committee has been formed to assist the Ghost Ranch Director in established criteria and procedures and in administration of this scholarship fund. This committee includes representatives from among the Pueblo people.
